Instructions for using eLearning discount codes

You will need your organisation's discount code, which you should have received in your welcome email. If you cannot find this, please email education@stonewall.org.uk

1. Select the module in our [online shop](#). Please note that your membership only includes access to courses aimed at Schools & Colleges in England.
2. Add the number of places required to the quantity and click 'Add to cart'. If you wish to purchase additional places beyond the number included in your membership, you will need to purchase these using a **separate transaction**.
3. Click 'Checkout' to proceed to the payment page. If you have an account with Stonewall's online shop, you'll be asked to log on. **Please note that these log in details are different to your log in details for www.stonewall.org.uk and the Stonewall Learning platform.**
4. Please fill in the details on this page with your organisation's information.
5. In the box 'gift card or discount code' type in your organisation's discount code and click 'apply'. This should apply the free places.
6. Proceed to payment options (which should appear as £0.00) and complete the order
7. If you wish to book additional places at the member only rate of £25 + VAT, repeat the process described about using the discount code MEM£10, then follow the payment instructions.

Please do not share your discount code with staff from other settings or services. Use of Stonewall Learning discount codes is monitored and any misuse will be in breach of the Stonewall Learning [terms and conditions](#).

How to get started with your e-learning, once you've purchased the spaces for your setting

1. After completing the transaction via our online shop, you should be redirected to the Stonewall Learning platform, if not, don't worry – you will receive an e-mail which invites you to get started too.
2. Click the hyperlink in the email to take you to the Stonewall Learning platform and create a Stonewall Learning account. **Please note that your log in details for Stonewall Learning will be different to your log in details for www.stonewall.org.uk or for our online shop.**

4. Click 'add participants' then click the 'invite by e-mail' tab. Add the e-mail addresses of each person you are inviting to take the training. At first only 3 boxes will appear, but additional spaces will appear as you add more e-mail addresses.

Invitees will then have one month to access their module so make sure your due date falls within this one-month period.
