- Make a page for a fact file about Catherine Duleep Singh.

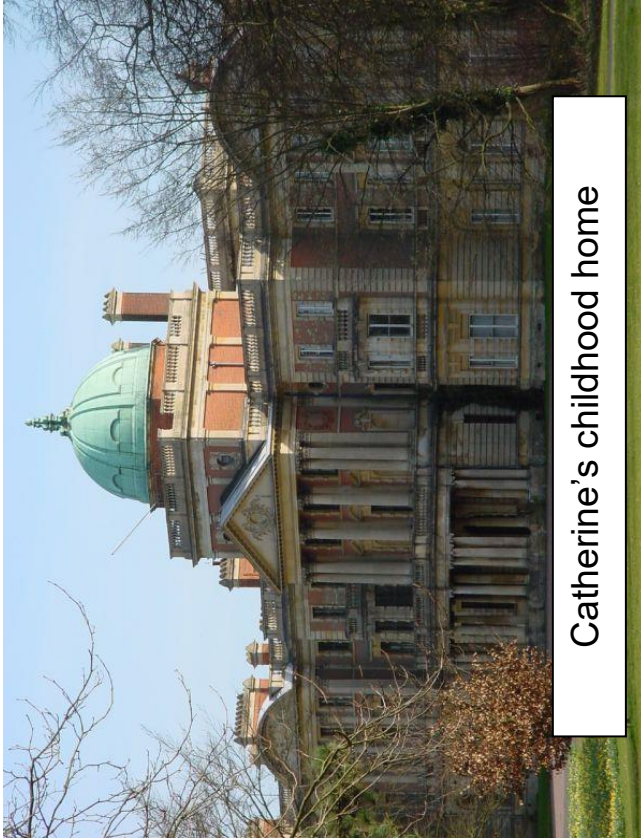

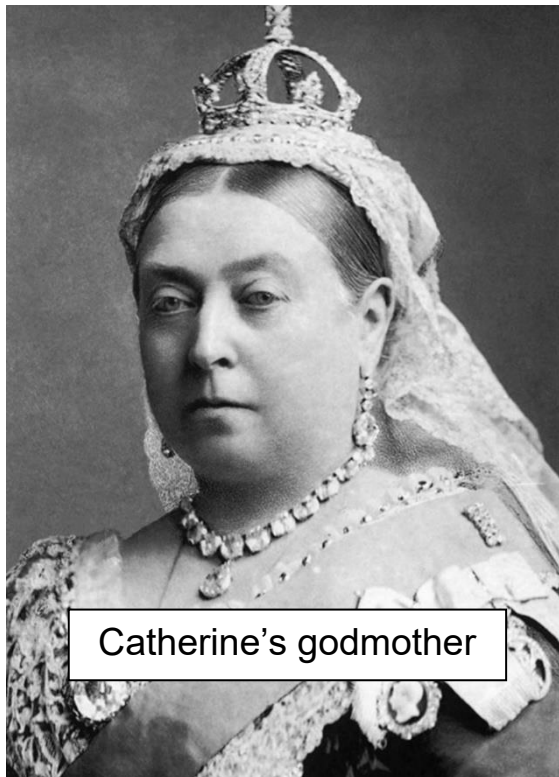
