Learning objectives

To explore photos and items relating to the past OR

Activity	Details	Resources
Whole class activity: Who was Catherine?	Explain to students that they're going to be learning about a woman named Catherine Duleep Singh, who lived a long time ago. Put all the artefacts into different coloured bags or boxes. Give each student the chance to open one of the bags or boxes and explore the artefact. They should then show it to the rest of the group. For each artefact, click on the corresponding photo on the PowerPoint. Talk about the event from Catherine's life related to the artefact before returning to the main page of the PowerPoint.
